The Potomac River Finfish Advisory Committee, which is comprised of private citizens and industry representatives, will meet at **6:00 p.m. on Wednesday, January 24, 2018** in the John T. Parran Hearing Room in the PRFC Office, Colonial Beach, Virginia.

Items on the agenda will include, but may not be limited to: a comprehensive performance review of the 2017 commercial striped bass fishery and tag exchange program review; considering an administrative fee for assigned users for all companies with fish gear; review of current finfish license fees; ASMFC issues including MD Striped Bass proposal, American Eel and Cobia; updates on the Harry Nice Bridge replacement and Dominion Coal Ash.
