Items to be discussed include: results of the 2017/2018 Winter Dredge Survey, a review of the 2018 preliminary crab harvest report, a discussion of possible 2018/2019 crab management responses, a discussion of Reg. 1, Sec. 2(d)(1) regarding one person/one license/one vessel, a discussion of PRFC financials and commercial crab license fee changes, an update on the Harry Nice Bridge project, a bycatch discussion, a review of the CPID costs & shipping/handling, and an update on electronic reporting.
