I**, Sec. 4 – Revocation Reciprocity – to amend Regulation 1, Sec. 4 by 1. adding new outline designations and adding Section 4(a)(iv) in order to review license status in foreign jurisdictions, including Maryland and Virginia, of applicants for or holders of a license with the Potomac River Fisheries Commission and accordingly restrict Commission license if restricted, revoked, or suspended elsewhere.

Amend Reg. I, Sec. 2(d)(5) – <u>Crab Pot ID Tags/Decals Fee and Replacement</u> – to 2. eliminate the "inactive" crab pot status and require all crabbers to pay for their CP ID Tags/Decals during renewal; an administrative fee will be required for CP ID Decals ordered after January 31.
