Potomac River Fisheries Commission Meeting

Chairman Robert Boarman announced today the Potomac River Fisheries Commission will hold its next regular meeting on **Thursday, December 2, 2021 at 8:30 a.m.** in the John T. Parran Hearing Room at the PRFC Commission Office. Chairman Boarman invites all interested persons to attend this open public meeting.

Items on the agenda include: The season, size, and catch limits for the 2022 recreational and commercial fisheries will be adopted; ASMFC issues including Striped Bass Amendment VII, Atlantic Croaker and Spot commercial harvest reductions, Atlantic Menhaden updates and quota transfer to the state of Maine; Crab harvest report; and Oyster issues including preliminary harvest report, OSPP membership, status of oyster projects, and preliminary Fall Survey results.

The nominating committee will be appointed, as well as the announcement of advisory committee nominee appointments.
