SPORT FISHING IN THE TIDAL POTOMAC RIVER LEGAL SIZES, LIMITS AND OTHER RESTRICTIONS

A Sport Fishing License is Required • Possession of Fillets is Prohibited • Any Fish Caught with Hook and Line May Not Be Sold or Offered for Sale (except by commercial license) • Any Fish Whose Size is Prohibited, Season is Closed, or is in Excess of the Possession Limit Must be Immediately Released to the Waters Where Found * No High-Grading Allowed * It Shall be Unlawful to Possess a Live Snakehead Fish or to Return, Release, or Otherwise Discard Any Living Snakehead Fish to the Potomac River.


