Potomac River Fisheries Commission Meeting

Colonial Beach, VA —

Chairman Phil L. Langley announced today the Potomac River Fisheries Commission will hold its next regular meeting on **Friday, September 20 at 8:30 a.m.** in the John T. Parran Hearing Room of the Potomac River Fisheries Commission (The Carpenter Building), 222 Taylor Street, Colonial Beach, Virginia. Chairman Langley invites all interested persons to attend this open public meeting.

Items on the agenda include: a report on the crab harvest, a summary of the August ASMFC meeting, adopting the 2019-2020 Striped Bass gill net season dates, possible expansion of PRFC artificial reef sites, the 2019-2020 oyster season dates, river wide daily bushel limits for oysters, and the status of the Potomac River Atlantic Menhaden harvest. Summary reports from the Finfish Advisory the Oyster/Clam Advisory committees will be provided, as well as a discussion of ASMFC Striped Bass Draft Addendum VI.
